POULTRY FARMERS, CHICKEN SELLERS, HANDLERS AND TRANSPORTERS

- Avoid direct contact with Chicken. Use gloves and other suitable protection.
- DO NOT touch bird feathers, mucus and droppings.
- In case of any contact, wash your hands with soap or detergent immediately.
- Keep your birds in enclosures.
- Safe disposal of dead/culled birds is a vital step to control the spread of infection.

REPORT sick or dead birds to the Animal Husbandry Department IMMEDIATELY without fail. It is safe to consume well cooked chicken & eggs.
