Starting Microsoft Windows XP Professional

To start Windows XP

- 1. Turn on your computer.
- Type your user name and password in the Log
 On to Windows dialog box and click OK.
- 3. Click Exit in the bottom-right corner of the Getting Started With Windows XP dialog box, if it appears.

Starting a Program

To start a program

- Double-click the program's icon on the desktop.
 Or
- Click the Start button, point to All Programs, and then click the program that you want to open.

Moving a Window

To move a window

• Drag the window's title bar to the desired location.

Closing a Window

To close a window

• Click the Close button in the top-right corner of the window.

Resizing a Window

To change the size and shape of a window

 Drag the resize area or click the Minimize, Maximize, or Restore Down buttons.

Logging Off Windows

To log off Windows XP

- 1. Click the Start button, then click the Log Off option at the bottom of the Start menu.
- 2. When the Log Off Windows dialog box appears, click Log Off.

Shutting Down Windows

To shut Windows down

- 1. Click the Start button and then click Shut Down.
- If necessary, click the down arrow in the
 Windows Shut Down dialog box. Click Shut
 Down in the list and then click OK.
- 3. Turn off the computer.
