## Office Memorandum

Subject: Sectoral Innovation Council on Child Sex Ratio (CSR).

The Census 2011 has shown a sharp decline in Child Sex Ratio (age group of 0-6 years) compared to the previous Census. It has declined to 914 in 2011 from 927 in 2001 and has been continuing unabated since 1961 despite improvements in other social indicators such as literacy, gender gap in effective literacy rate, overall sex ratio, etc. The decline in CSR has spread to 22 States and 5 Union Territories with highest decline in J&K State.

In view of such an alarming situation, Government of India have decided to set up a Sectoral Innovation Council on CSR to look at the entire gamut of issues connected with the declining child sex ratio with a purpose of identifying interventions which have worked and those which did not, and also to suggest innovative strategies, approaches and methods of intervention to address the decline in CSR problem in a time bound and effective manner.

The Council will have the following composition and shall submit its recommendations within eight weeks:
